TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Interested participants must be a **registered Gobeshona conference participant**.
- Interested participants will have to attend networking sessions to meet, discuss and prepare a short abstract (not more than 1 page) of their idea before the Conference.
- **On 22 January**, the 5th day of Gobeshona Conference, abstracts will be solicited from groups.
- **6 best ideas** will be selected to go to the next round
- Names of the winning teams will be announced at the closing session.
- Winning teams will have to provide a detail proposal within **1 week** of Gobeshona conference.
- Upon final selection, each team will receive a small grant of **USD 5000** to implement their idea.

- Summary of the project idea
- Number of members in the group (Max 3 persons)
- Names, affiliations and contact details of the team participants (please highlight the **team coordinator**)
- Name of the countries in the group
